Meanings of words:

**Allegro**-fast, quick    **Andante**- walking tempo    **Largo**- slow

**Brass**- instruments you buzz into, made of brass

**Woodwinds**- instruments you blow into, some use reeds and others have a tone hole

**Piano**- soft                      **Forte**- loud

**Legato**- long, smooth, and connected

**Staccato**- disconnected

This piece has many meter changes, meaning the beats per measure and note value that receives the beat change. The first meter is 4/4, which means there are four beats per measure and a quarter note receives the beat.
